

The 2016 Bible Reading Marathon will be held at the Gazebo on the Monroe Town Green Thursday, August 18 through Saturday, August 20 from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm daily.

UMC Monroe has signed up for the following dates and 2-hour sessions:

Thursday, August 18 – noon – 2:00 pm (Bible Study and All Church Family) Friday, August 19 – 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm (Youth and All Church Family) Saturday, August 20 – 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm (All Church Family)

We're looking for a minimum of 8 participants per session. Each person will read for 15 minutes. While UMC Monroe has signed up for the reported 2-hour blocks, you are welcome to stop by and participate at any time!

Tips for our readers and anyone planning to stop by the Gazebo:

- Please plan to arrive at the Gazebo 10 minutes ahead of your time slot, with a prayerful attitude and expectation of what God has prepared.
- Dress casually and be comfortable for rain or shine, day or night!
- We will be reading the New Testament. Feel free to bring your own Bible or use the one that is provided. You can read from any translation and in any language.
- Don't forget reading glasses and additional lighting/flashlights, if needed.
- Bring a journal and remember a pen! Write down anything that God highlights as His Word is being proclaimed by the other members. Yes -- we are called to Read and called to Listen!
- As part of our Faith in Action, we'd like to encourage each new team to pray for the team that proceeds them ... and then the first team can pray for the new team that's following them, before they leave.
- The only seating in the Gazebo is hard benches bring folding chairs, if needed.
- · Bottled water will be available during our sessions.






2016 Surf Shack Vacation Bible School

Celebrating Marilyn


