# **Craft One: Fluffy Handprint**




## Supplies

- Paper
- Cotton balls
- Glue
- Markers/decorative materials

### Procedure:

- 1. Trace a child's hand on construction paper.
- 2. Flip the paper around so that the thumb is the "head" of the sheep and the fingers are the legs. Allow the child to color or decorate as desired.
- 3. Glue on cotton balls to make wool. Allow the sheep to dry.



# **Craft Two: Sheep Puppet**



## Supply List:

- Paper bag
- Cotton balls
- Glue; scissors
- Markers/decorative materials
- Google eyes (optional)

### Procedure:

- 1. Decorate the paper bag with markers. Add eyes, ears, and mouth features, if desired.
- 2. Glue cotton balls on the front of the bag for sheep wool.
- 3. Allow to dry, and let your sheep "speak" by moving the bag with your hand!



## Craft Three: Jesus Had a Little Lamb Mask



### Craft Supplies:

- Paper plate
- Cotton balls
- Glue, scissors
- Markers/decorative materials
- Popsicle stick (optional)



### How To Make the Lamb Mask

- 1. Cut a face-sized hole inside the paper plate. It may be easier to fold in half first.
- 2. Color the outside, if desired.
- 3. Glue cotton balls around the border of the plate.
- 4. Attach paper ears and ribbon, if you like.
- 5. Optionally, add a popsicle stick to hold up the mask.
- 6. Smile and say "baaaa"!

# Craft Four: Cuppa Lamb



### You Will Need:

- Styrofoam cup Cotton balls
- Glue
- Clothespins
- Google eyes
- Markers to decorate (optional)



- 1. Decorate the foam cup, if desired.
- 2. Glue cotton balls around the cup.
- 3. Affix clothespins to the bottom for "legs." Color pins if you like.
- 4. Attach an extra cotton ball or pom pom "head" with google eyes.
