

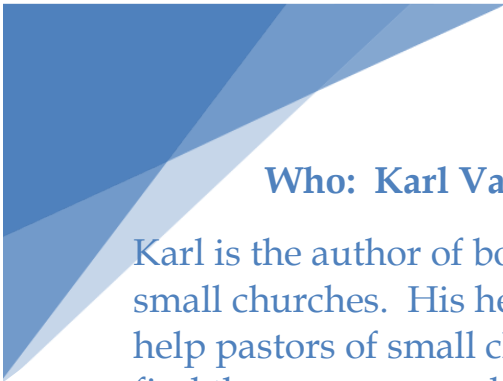

A time apart with author Karl Vaters

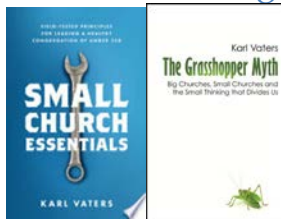
