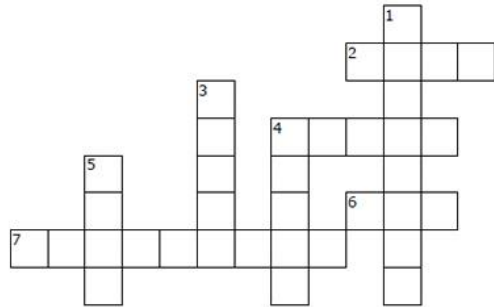


# Crossword Puzzle

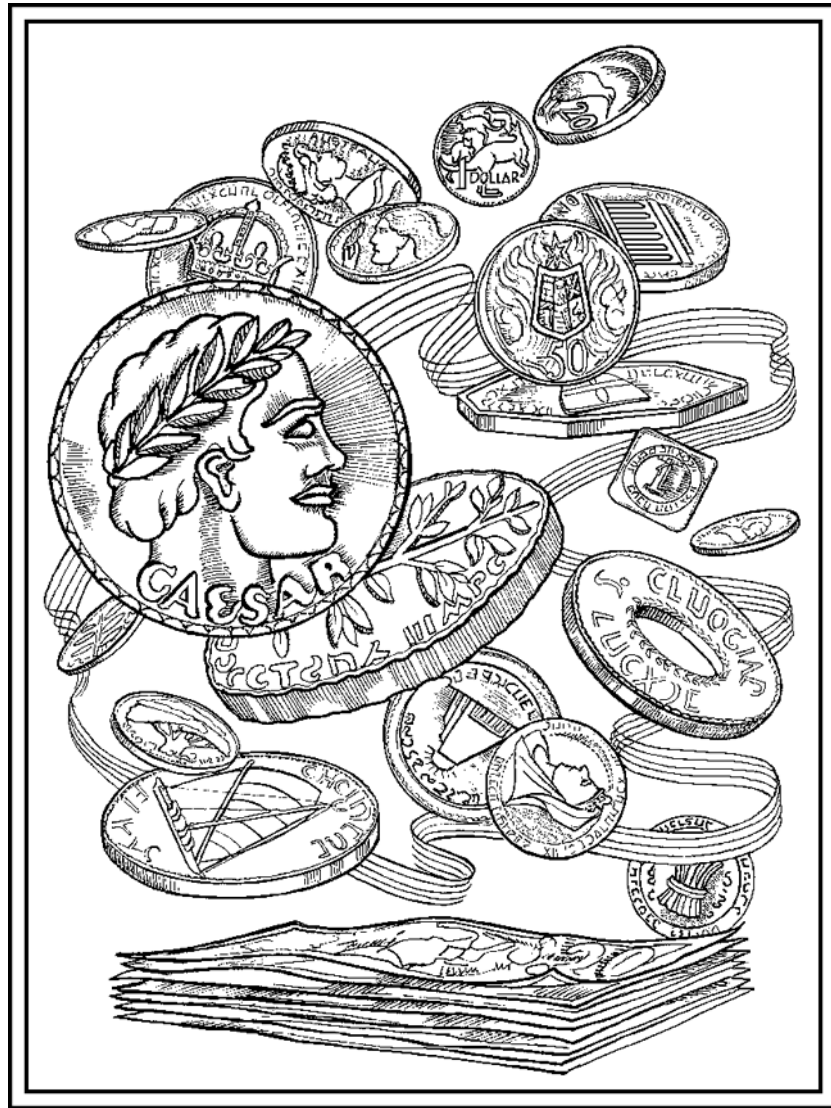
