

In October 2024, HBV launched full-time programming and secured financial support for 10 full-time members.

HBV Achievements to Date:

Average Daily Attendance: 25 members

Groups Held: 778 sessions

Average Group Size: 12 participants **Educational Classes Attended: 8,988** Full-Time Members Supported: 27

HBV Positive Outcomes:

Only 7% reincarcerated 16 secured employment
